

# Behaviour in case of an emergency in the Power Tower

## Fire



### Alarm

- Stay calm
- Press the manual button or alert the fire department

Phone: 112



### Rescue and warning

- Provide assistance
- Warn persons who are exposed to danger
- Rescue disabled and injured persons



### Extinguish fire

- Do not put yourself in danger!
- Use a fire extinguisher/hose reel for fire fighting



### Close

- Close windows and doors when leaving the building (to prevent fire and smoke from spreading)



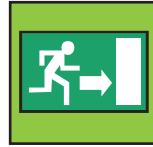
### Attention!

- Never use the elevators during a fire
- Use the stairs to exit the building and go directly to the meeting point

## Evacuation



### Alarm

- When the alarm rings, leave the building immediately and calmly by the nearest emergency exit route



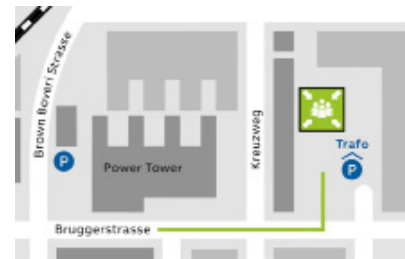
### Follow

- Follow the instructions of emergency organisations and information sheets
- Never use the elevator for evacuations
- Support disabled and injured persons



### Meet

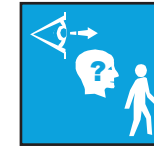
- Meeting point is the Trafo-Platz
- Do not leave the meeting point without permission from the operational command



### Important!

- Never return to the danger zone

## First Aid



### Basic principles

- Look (Review the situation)
- Think (Recognize subsequent hazards)
- Act (Protect yourself, secure the accident site)



### Rescue

- Protect yourself (use gloves)
- Do not put yourself in danger
- Rescure injured persons from the danger zone



### Alarm

- Company doctor
  - from landline: 114
  - from mobile: 44 114
- Ambulance Phone: 112
  - Where is the accident site?
  - Who is calling?
  - What happened?
  - When did the accident occur?
  - How many people are injured?



### Assistance

- Attend to injured persons until medical help arrives
- Brief and support rescue teams



### Location Defibrillators

- Block B, ground floor, main stairway
- Block B, first floor, emergency stairway
- Block B, fifth floor, main stairway
