

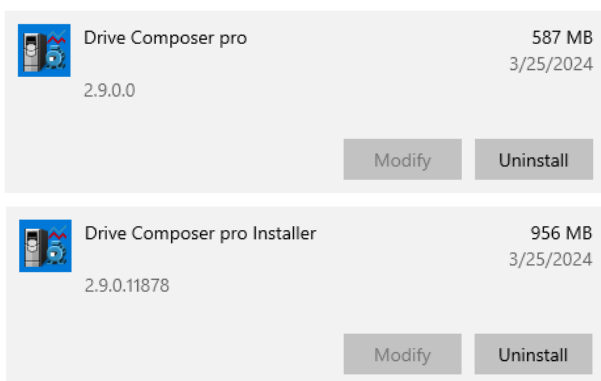

How to downgrade Drive Composer Pro software

Process of what needs to be removed before installing an older version of Drive Composer Pro.

This document discusses how to downgrade Drive Composer and what needs to be uninstalled in order to install a previous version of the software (Example: going from 2.9 version to 2.8. version).


The first thing that needs to be done is to uninstall the version that is currently installed on the PC. To do this open add or remove programs and find Drive Composer Pro and Drive Composer Pro Installer and uninstall them.



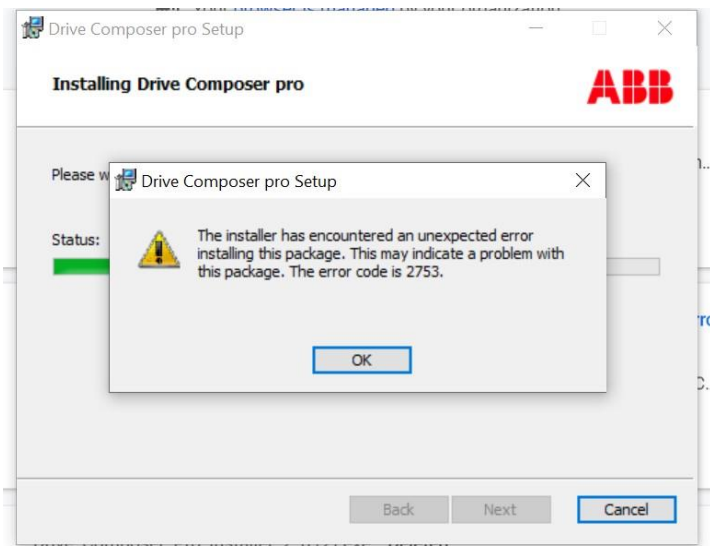
After this there may be another component installed called DriveDAOPCServer. If that is present in add/remove programs, uninstall that as well.



Next, navigate to C:\Program Files (x86)\Common Files\DriveWare and delete the DriveDA folder, if present.

If the DDriveDAOPCServer is not uninstalled or the DriveDA folder is not deleted, the user may see the following error when trying to install Drive Composer Pro. If this happens, make sure to go back and follow the steps above.



Now that Drive Composer Pro is uninstalled, the desired version can be installed from the .exe download. To download Drive Composer Pro, see the link below.
