

INTEGRA IT-8000 Vulnerability Fix

Summary

Niagara Framework® has been updated to address a vulnerability in the libwebp component utilized by jxBrowser. The CVE reported is [CVE-2023-4863](#) and has been rescored as [6.8](#), based on the libwebp component's usage in Niagara.
