# AFCI, GFCI & DFCI

## Test instructions / Instructions de test



1. Ensure the load center has power and the breaker handle is in the ON position.
2. Press test button in the “up” position. Reset breaker if handle moves to “TRIP” position. Repeat by pressing the test button in the “down” position.

**CAUTION: If the breaker fails to go to the “TRIP” position after pressing the test button, replace the breaker.**

1. Assurez-vous que le panneau de distribution est alimenté et que la manette du disjoncteur est positionnée sur ON.
2. Appuyez sur le bouton de test en position “haute”. Réinitialisez le disjoncteur si la manette passe à la position “TRIP”. Répétez en appuyant sur le bouton de test dans la position “bas”.

**ATTENTION: Si le disjoncteur ne parvient pas à se mettre en position “TRIP” après avoir appuyé sur le bouton de test, remplacez le disjoncteur.**
