

Life Saving Rules

I apply the seven steps to electrical work

- 1 Prepare for work. Do an on-site risk assessment or hazard analysis.
- 2 Clearly identify the workplace and equipment.
- 3 Disconnect all sources and secure them against reconnection.
- 4 Verify the absence of operating voltage. Always test before you touch.
- 5 Carry out earthing and short-circuiting.
- 6 Protect against adjacent live parts and take special precautions when close to bare conductors.
- 7 Complete the work permit and "walk the permit."

Remember: Check the availability of emergency equipment before the intervention begins.
