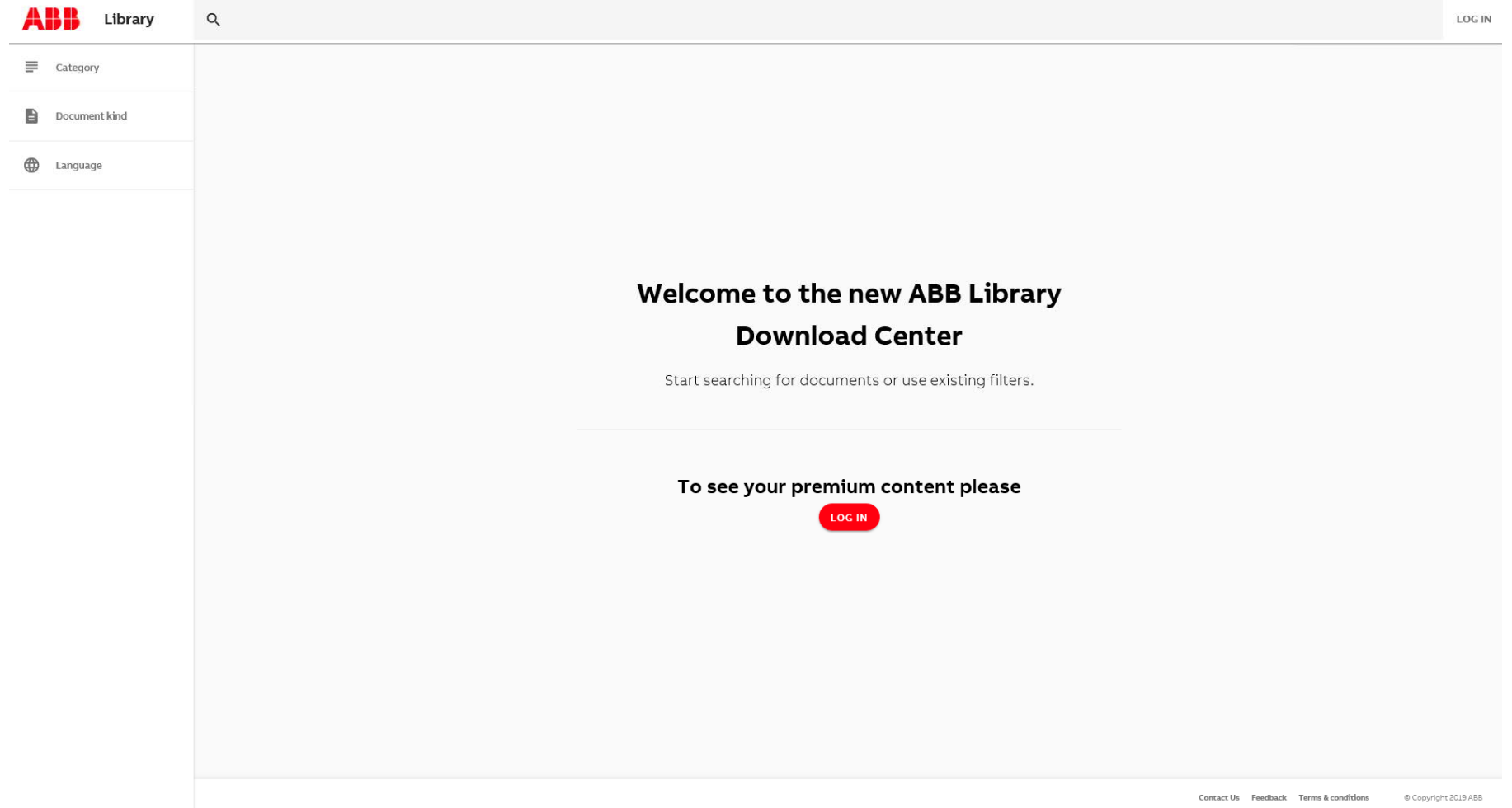
# Important notices




Since this is the first Log in, you have to set your main Log in password by pressing the “Forgot your password” red text as showed in the picture (1).

To move on with the procedure, insert your registered email (2), and press the “SEND EMAIL” red button.

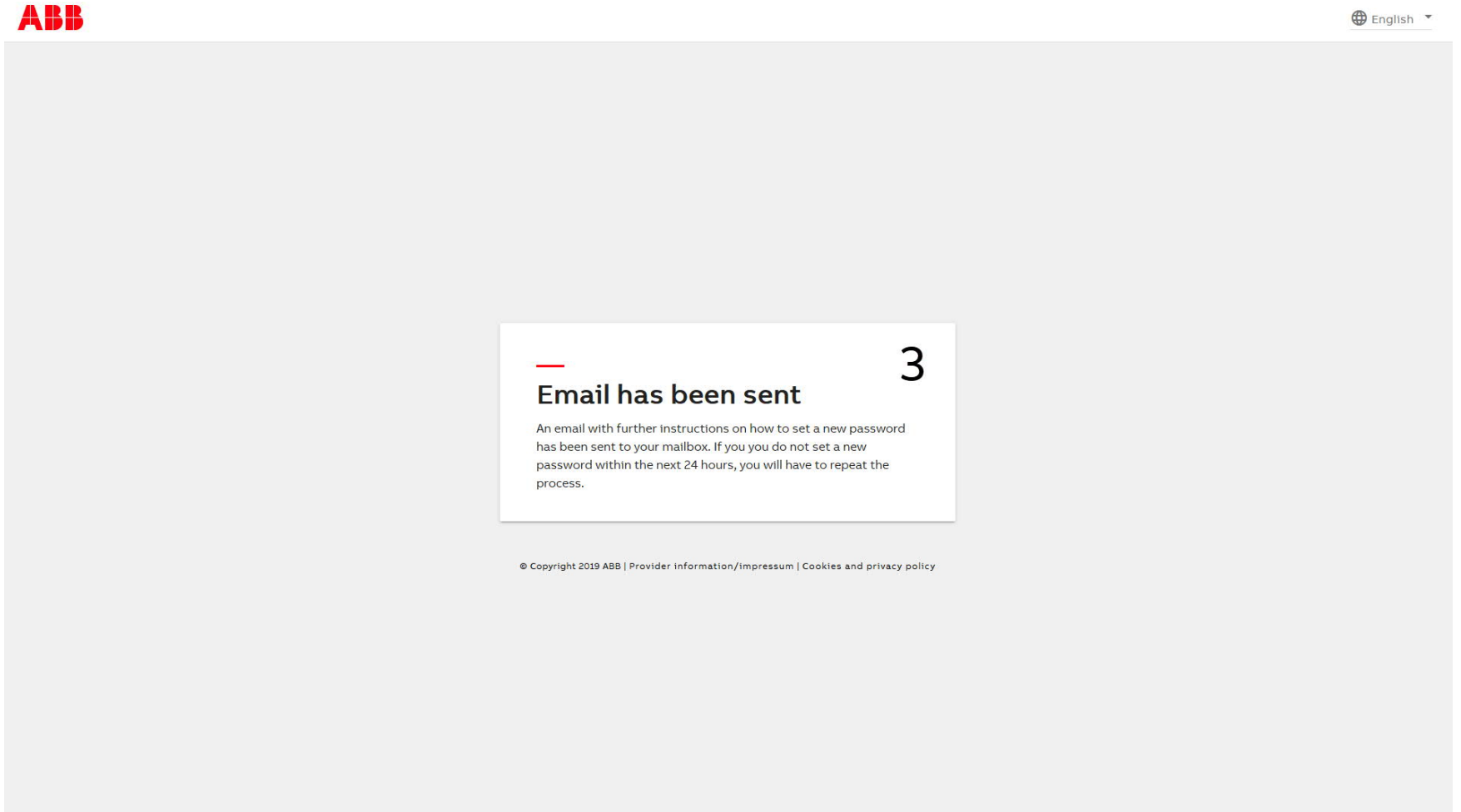

After pressing the red “SET NEW PASSWORD” button from the email sent at your mail box, you will be moved at the “Set new password” page, as showed in the picture.

- The system will ask you the choose a “Security question” (5).
- Write the answer of your security question (6).
- Insert your main Log in password (7).
- Reinsert your main Log in password (8).
- Press the red “SET PASSWORD” button.

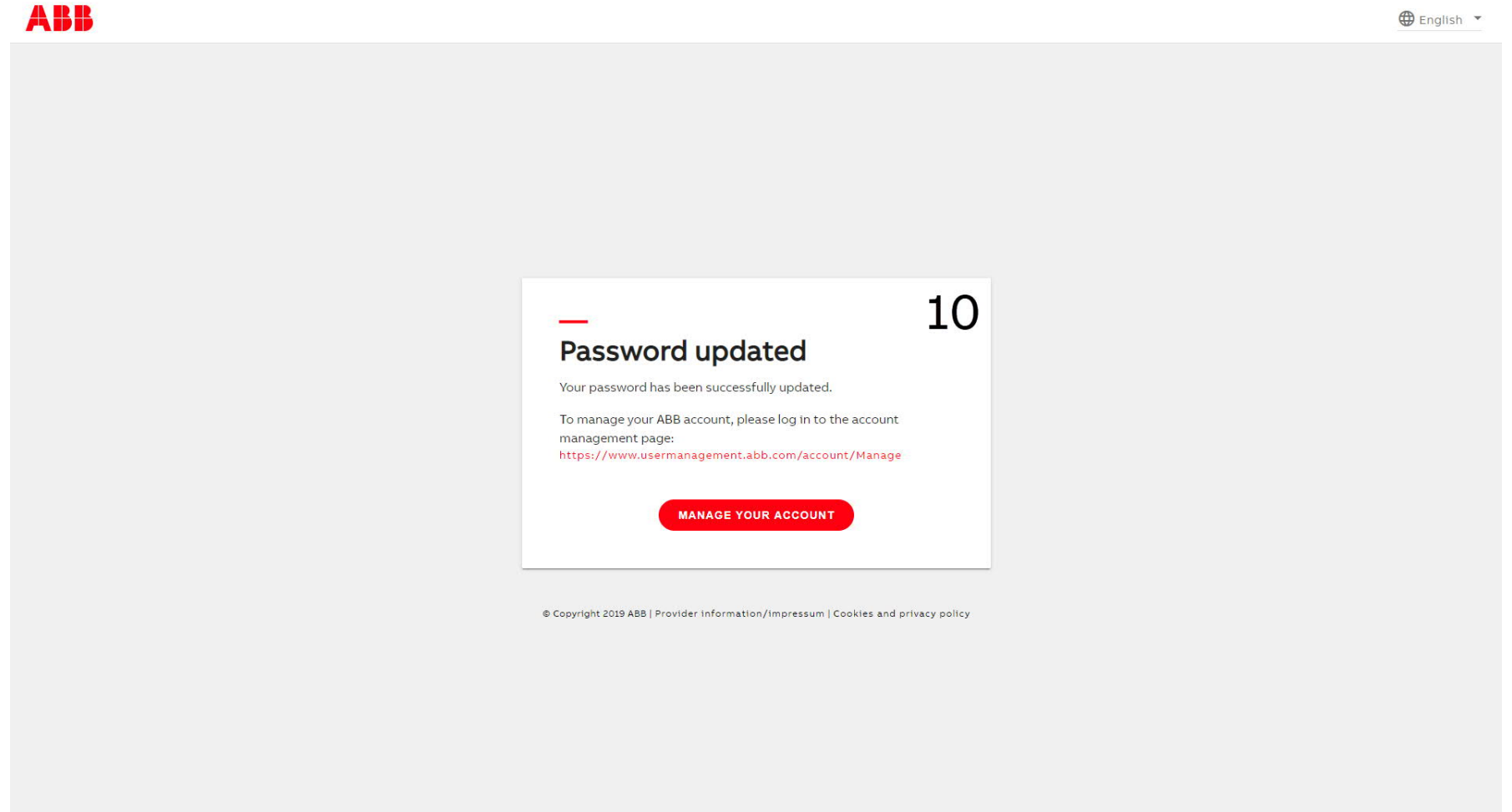

Now you have access to the library.

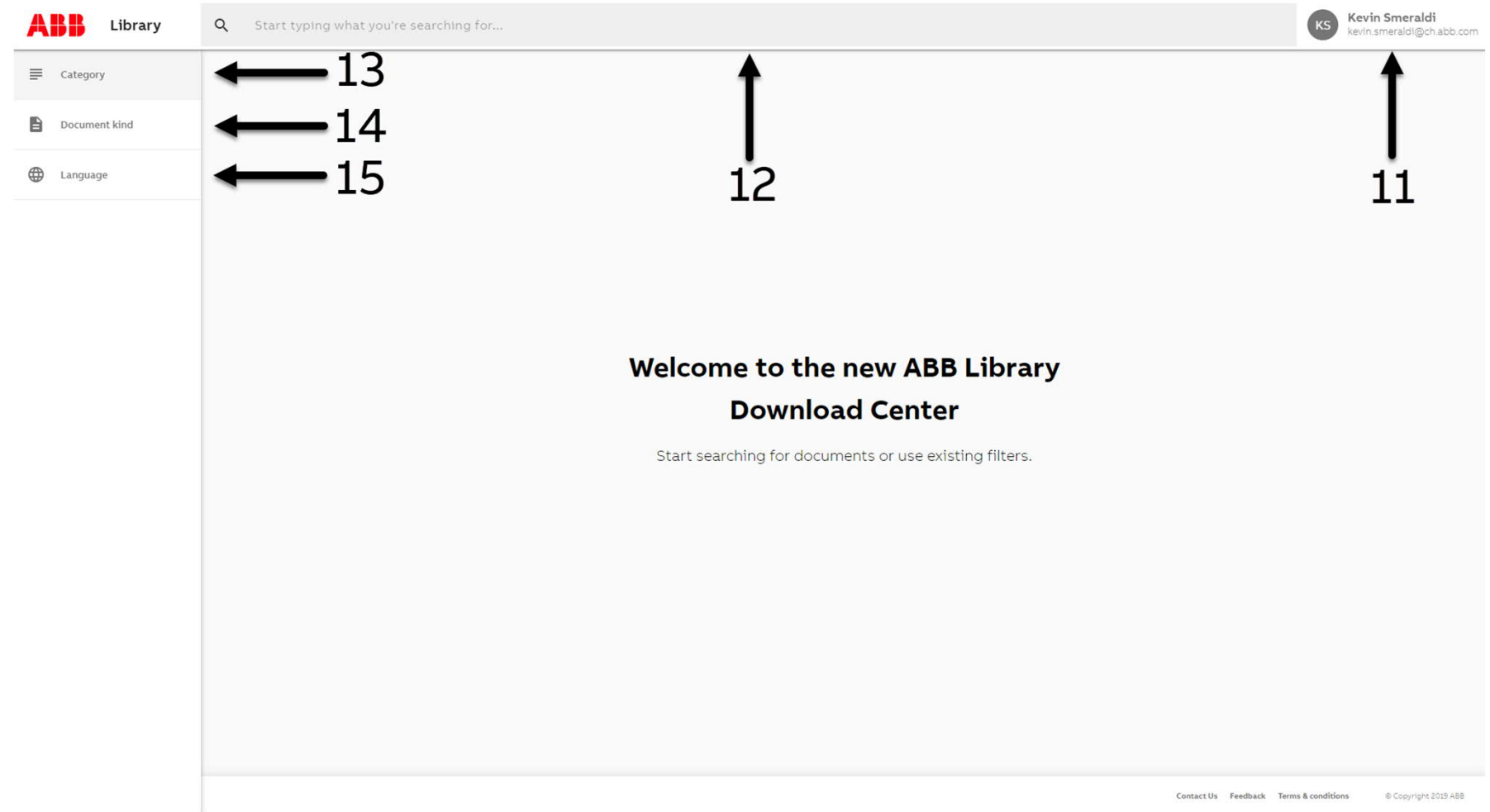
11) IMPORTANT: You must be always Logged in to have access at all documents that your accounts allows you to see. If you are not Logged in, you will see only the “Public” documents.
