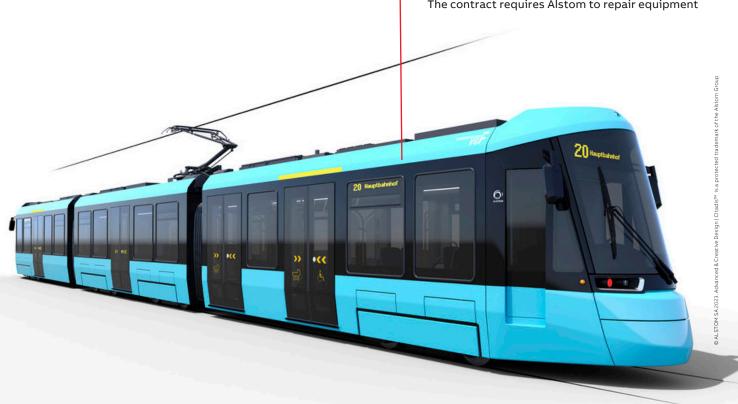

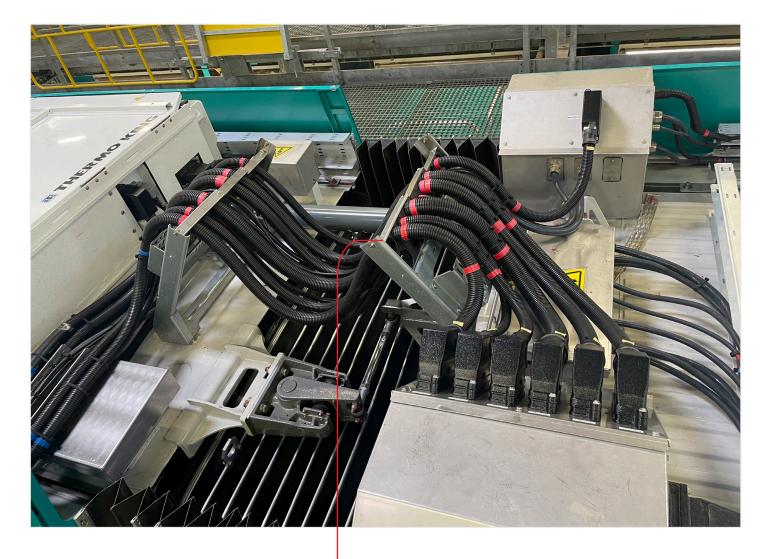

The roof of a tram is a complex space that contains a wide variety of electrical components including high-voltage cables, communication systems, and other critical equipment. ABB's PMA® modular support system PMA® TRUST™ is the perfect solution for safe and reliable fixation.

Deeply rooted in the Spanish railway tradition, Alstom has been manufacturing trains in Spain for over 150 years, with a long history of innovation and commitment to Spain's economic and industrial development. In 2018 Alstom signed a contract with Verkehrsgesellschaft Frankfurt am Main GmbH (VGF), the transport operator in Frankfurt am Main, Germany, for the supply of 43 Citadis trams. 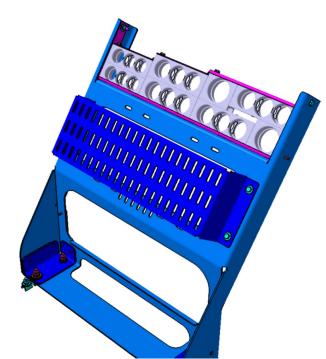

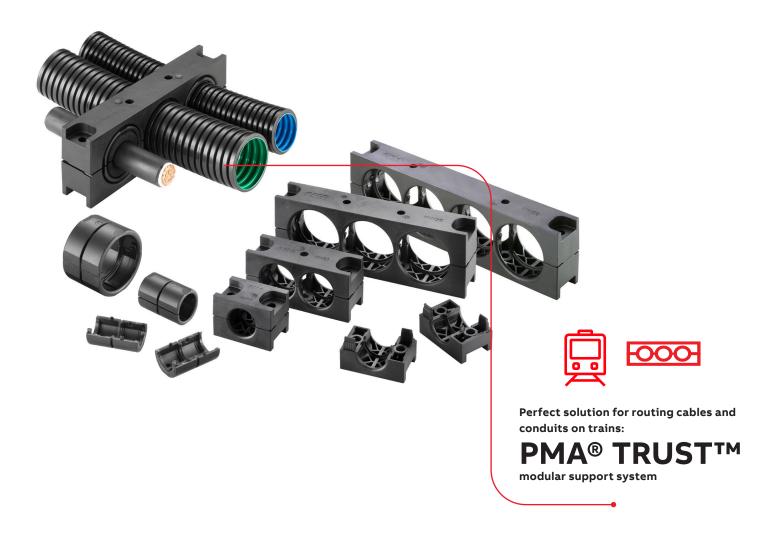

transitions of electrical cables and conduits are an
essential part of ensuring the safe and efficient
operation of the vehicle. They must be designed and
manufactured to the highest standards to ensure
that they can withstand operating conditions and
provide reliable and safe electrical power to the
entire tram.

Alstom had a need to combine the fixing of different sizes of conduits and cables and it was critical to respect their positioning for correct operation. On the other hand, a standard and modular system was required to allow quick and easy installation of the cable protection.

A certified solution compliant with the EN 45545-2 standard on railway safety was required to support the cable protection system and install the conduits and cables in the carriage transition on the roof of the vehicle. Stringent requirements apply to this type of weather exposed solution on the roof of rail vehicle carriages – compliance with rail standards, adaptability, use of cables and conduits from a single source, and high weather-resistance. The PMA® TRUST™ system was the perfect solution for the application.



The modularity of the PMA Trust system allowed ALSTOM and PMA team to design together a solution that combined several sizes of conduits and cables.

Alstom and ABB Spain have a longstanding relationship which is why they relied on the local ABB team to define a PMA solution that leveraged the full range of PMA® TRUST™ support system to solve their need for compliance and reliability. The PMA® TRUST™ modular support system is a lightweight, compact solution with high impact-resistance. Thanks to the new design, external dimensions are reduced to the very minimum and internal spacing between adjoining conduits is very small. Each element can hold different combinations of both conduits and cables in various sizes.

The new modular support system offers total installation flexibility complying with numerous of installation requirements, so that cable routing is made easy regardless of its complexity. Thanks to the modular system, installation time is kept to a minimum. Multiple conduits and cables in various sizes can be clamped in one element which is then secured with just two screws. Moreover, this is a 45545-2 certified solution - a standard that applies to all manufacturers of rail vehicles. Once the PMA® TRUST™ system is installed, it provides a reliable and secure cable routing system for the electrical components on the tram. This helps to ensure the components remain protected and are able to function reliably even in harsh conditions.
