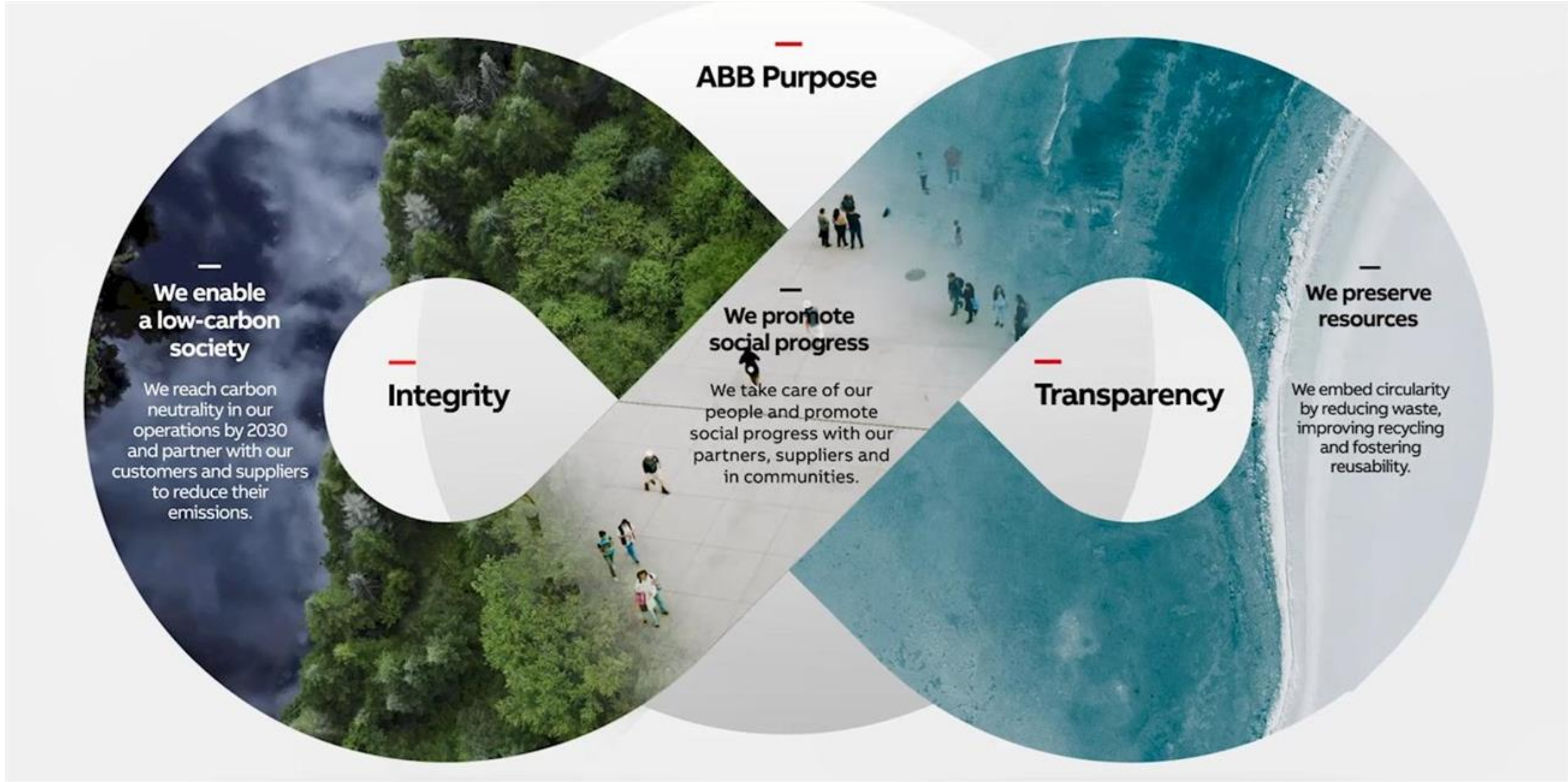

Introduction

SCM is critical to achieve the ambitious targets in our 2030 sustainability strategy.

The more we integrate suppliers into our sustainability activities, the more our impact will increase, creating momentum far beyond our own operations.

Low Carbon Supply Chain

Ambition:

We support and incentivize our suppliers to join our carbon reduction commitment.

Target:

At ABB Group: 50% CO2 emissions reduction from 70% of **Tier 1 direct and indirect material suppliers** spend by 2030 (EcoVadis tbd)

Responsible Sourcing

Ambition:

We engage with our suppliers to promote labor and human rights, and improve health, safety and environmental conditions in the supply chain.

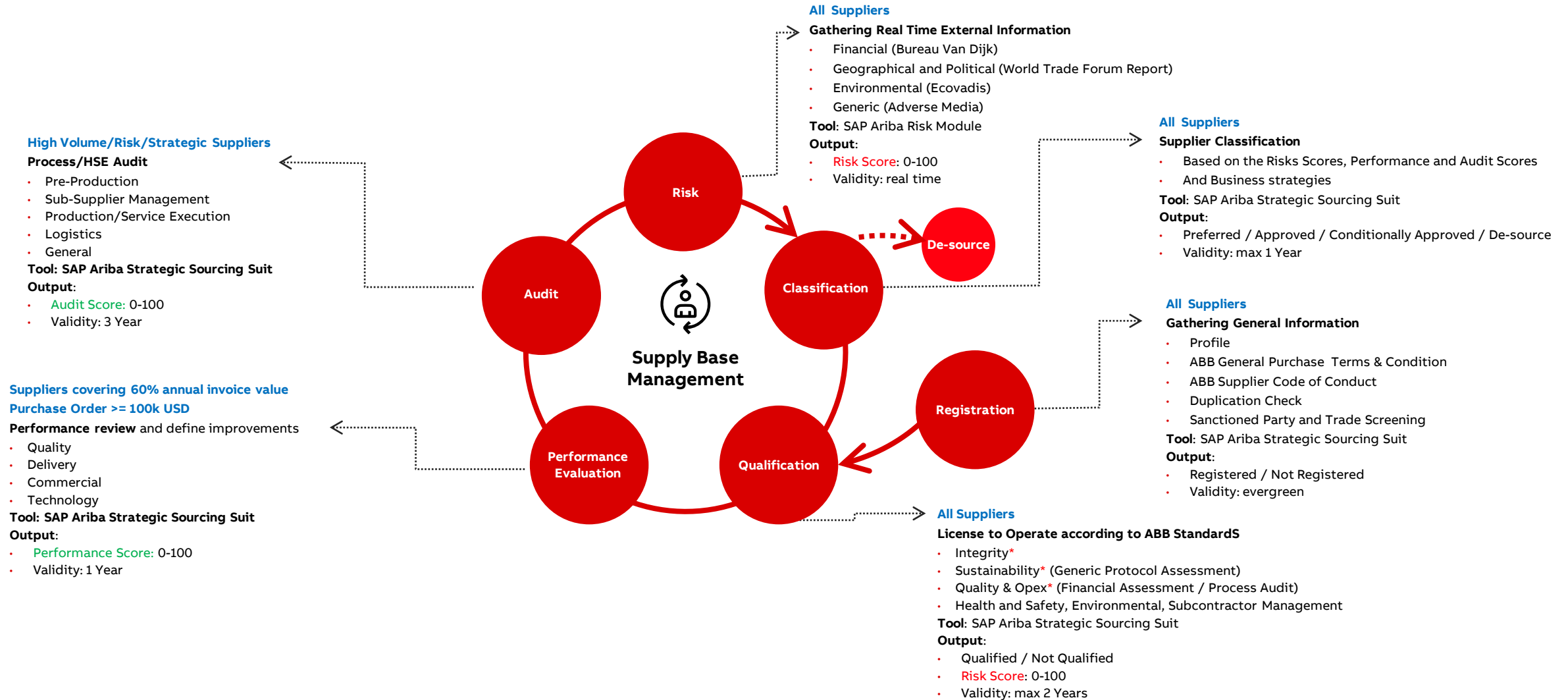
Targets:

80% of supply spend in focus countries covered by SSBM (Sustainability Supply Base Management)

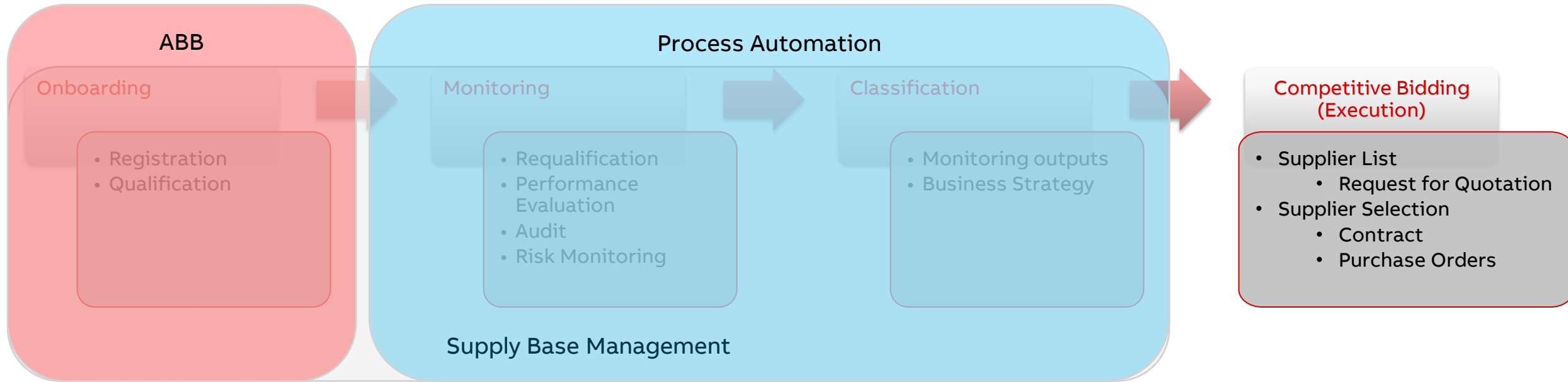
