
How to get to ABB Mannheim



Arriving from the autobahn

Exit the A 6 autobahn at the Viernheimer interchange and drive onto the B 38 highway heading toward Mannheim-Käfertal. Continue for about four kilometers and turn left when you see the “ABB” sign, then right onto Kallstadter Str. At the first intersection. The reception (Gate 1) is on the left.

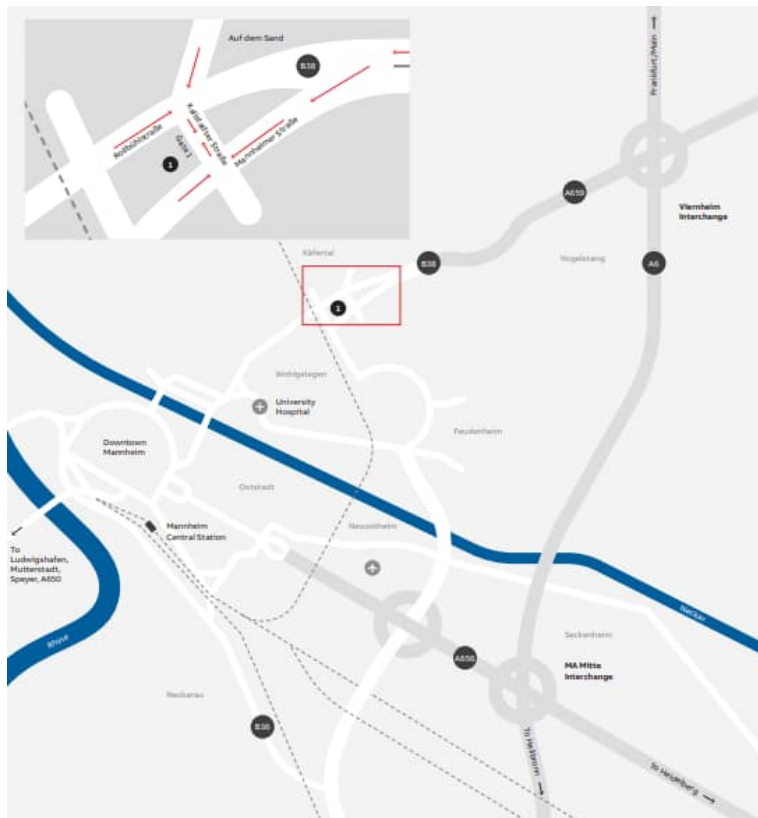
Arriving from downtown Mannheim

Take the B 38 highway heading toward Weinheim and turn right at the B 38/Kallstadter Str. Intersection following the “ABB” sign. The reception (Gate 1) is on the right.

Arriving by tram

At Mannheim central station take tram number 5 (OEG) heading toward Viernheim/Weinheim. Exit the tram at the “Käfertal Süd” stop across from the ABB site.

Arriving from the autobahn
Exit the A 6 autobahn at the Viernheimer Interchange and drive onto the B 38 highway heading toward Mannheim-Käfertal. Continue for about four kilometers and turn left when you see the "ABB" sign, then right onto Kallstadter Str. at the first intersection. The reception (Gate 1) is on the left.

Arriving from downtown Mannheim
Take the B 38 highway heading toward Weinheim and turn right at the B 38/Kallstadter Str. intersection. The reception (Gate 1) is on the right.

Arriving by tram
At Mannheim central station take tram number 5 or 5A heading toward Viernheim/Weinheim. Exit the tram at the "Käfertal Süd" stop across from the ABB site.

Travelling by plane

Frankfurt airport is located about 70 km (43 miles) from Mannheim. You can take a taxi or rental car that brings you in ~45min to Mannheim with a good motorway connection.

Upon timely request, we offer to arrange a Taxi transfer at preferred conditions ~80/100 Euro payable by you to the driver. Electronic payment terminals in taxis accept Visa, Mastercard and American Express cards.

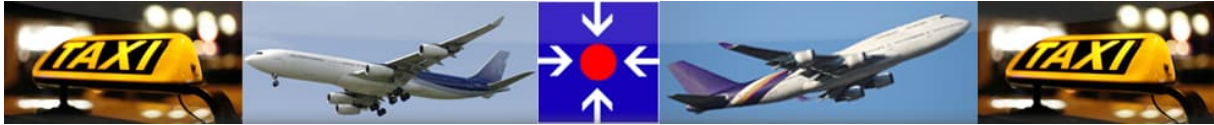
If you pick a standard taxi at the airport the charge to Mannheim ~120/140 Euro

Arriving from the autobahn

Exit the A 6 autobahn at the Viernheimer interchange and drive onto the B 38 highway heading toward Mannheim-Käfertal. Continue for about four kilometers and turn right onto Auf dem Sand, then left onto Galvanistraße. Follow Galvanistraße until Turbinenstraße. Galvanistraße runs to the right and turns into Turbinenstraße. Aurelis Tor 8 is signposted from the corner of Turbinenstrasse / Reichenbachstrasse.

Arriving from downtown Mannheim

Take the B 38 highway heading toward Weinheim and turn left onto Auf dem Sand, then left again onto Galvanistraße. Follow Galvanistraße until Turbinenstraße. Galvanistraße runs to the right and turns into Turbinenstraße. Aurelis Tor 8 is signposted from the corner of Turbinenstrasse / Reichenbachstrasse.

Arriving by tram

At Mannheim central station take tram number 5 (OEG) heading toward Viernheim/Weinheim. Exit the tram at the “Käfertal Süd” stop. Then walk on Rollbühlstraße/B38 to the west (19 m) turn right onto Auf dem Sand (290 m) and then turn left onto Galvanistraße. Follow Galvanistraße until Turbinenstraße. Galvanistraße runs to the right and turns into Turbinenstraße. Aurelis Tor 8 is signposted from the corner of Turbinenstrasse / Reichenbachstrasse.

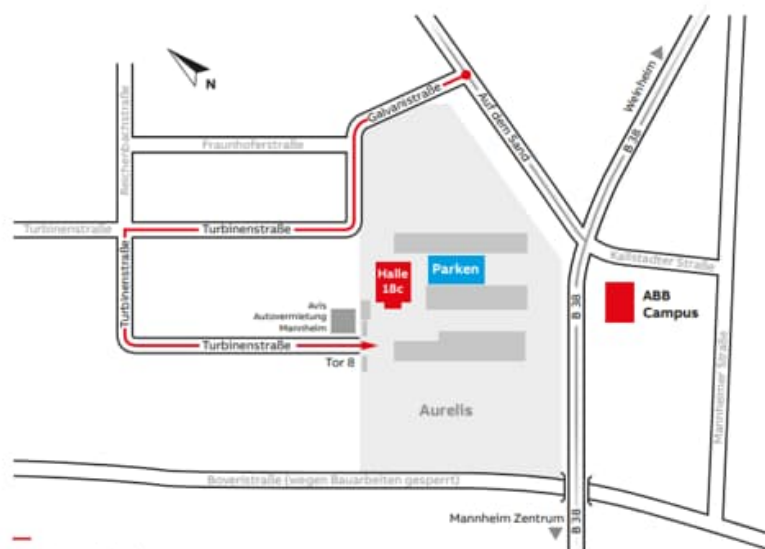

In case of fire

Call emergency number "Call emergency number before fighting fire"
Internal emergency number: 0100
When reporting a fire, indicate:

Where is the fire?
Building, floor, room number

Are people injured?

What is burning?
Type and amount of fire

Who is calling?
Name and phone number

Call in case of even the smallest fire as these can quickly become a large fire.

Are people in danger?

"Rescue people before fighting fire"
Find out if there are injured or endangered persons who must be taken out of the danger zone.

Stop anyone whose clothing has caught fire from coming away!

Put out burning clothing with other articles of clothing, fire blankets or by rolling these persons on the ground.

Attempt to put out fire

Use the designated equipment available to fight the fire (fire extinguishers, wall hydrants, etc.).

Use extinguishers to fight the source of the fire first.

Vacate the building

When the alarm sounds, remain calm and exit the building in an orderly manner. Help those who require additional assistance.

Exit buildings and workshops using the designated emergency exits. Close doors, in certain cases you will be told which paths and assembly points to use.

Meeting point

Meeting points are identified in the map of the premises by the following symbol.

Do not use elevators!

Fire brigade

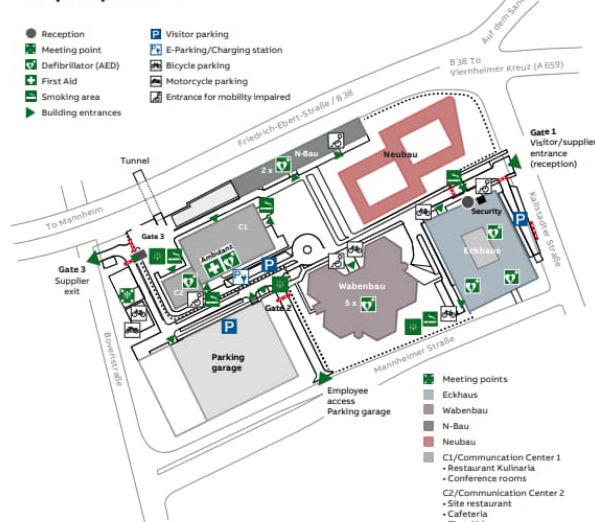
Upon arrival, the fire brigade takes over all firefighting activities. The head or deputy head of the fire brigade is responsible for fire fighting at the scene of the fire.

Obey instructions from the fire brigade!

After a fire

Notify the head of the department of any injuries to people and damage to property immediately after the fire has been put out.

General rules

These rules apply to all persons who enter or drive through the ABB site in Mannheim.

Obey the signs on plant property such as traffic and warning signs.
No photography or filming without prior approval.

- Smoking, fires and open flames are prohibited.
- Cell phones are prohibited. Turn off cell phones. Inquire about exceptions.
- The taking of photos is prohibited.
- Authorized personnel only.

The following applies in buildings:
Observe the emergency plans of the respective building.

Road traffic regulations apply throughout the entire site with the following exceptions:

- Speed limit: 20 km/h.
- Vehicles parked in violation of traffic regulations will be towed away at the owner's expense.
- The riding of bicycles on sidewalks is not permitted.

Obey instructions from plant security, fire fighters or supervisory staff.

Violators of the preceding rules may be banned from the site.
