Hardware Requirements

• You will need a **ZEBRA Printer**.

As of today, the ZT51042-T010000Z Thermal Transfer Printer with a ZebraNet Print Server II network card (part number: 46689) is the newest model. The Zebra 140Xi4 and the older Zebra printers will also work as long as they are network compatible and 203DPI.

Zebra 140xill, Zebra 140xill, Zebra 140xill Plus are 203 DPI. 300 & 600 DPI printers are not compatible with the 1800 label formats in the PDD system and cannot be used. Other models/brands might work as well if they are compatible with the printer ZT51042-T010000Z.

• You will need a bar code verifier. We recommend the Quick Check PC 600 with pen or QC 200 handheld model. You will also need to follow the ABB procedures for verifying bar codes. This will be provided to you before you begin printing labels from the system.

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Overview

The PDD Label Printing system allow facilities across the world to print product labels out of the PDD system. Few Terms used:

PDD Labels

• Product Labels printed in manufacturing plant to indicate what product is in the packaging. Since PDD is the Product Database, these are printed from it.

PDD Label User

• PDD user that uses the PDD Label screen to print the labels. They simply view the labels in PDD and click "Print Label" and select their quantity and printer to send the label to their printer.

PDD Label Admin

 Data administrators of the PDD Labels systems can insert labels records, update label data, and remove labels from PDD. They are usually the primary contacts between the plant and the PDD team regarding labels. They drive any label system changes and must be notified any time the Label system changes.

WP (Where Print)

• Where Prints indicate the location where the label is primary printed.

PDD Vendors/Suppliers

Printer set up Initiation

Printer set up for Vendors/Suppliers should be initiated by the Procurement Category Managers of ABB in their respective regions.

Process Flow – Printer Set Up

Printer Set Up Initiation

Email Registration (self-register)

Printer set up for Vendors/Suppliers should be initiated by the Procurement Category Managers of ABB in the respective regions.

Procurement Category Manager will send the doc "PDD Labeling Support Guide" to supplier.

Complete Printer Set Up form

Vendors/Suppliers must fill the "ABB PDD Printer Set up Request Form" and send it to the Procurement Category Manager.

Password Change/Reset

PDD Vendors/Suppliers

- Reset password for registered email ID: It would have been locked on the ABB portal. Try resetting your password using this link: <u>https://www.usermanagement.abb.com/account/ForgotPassword</u>
- PDD site may locked if the account is inactive for 60 days. In this case, a ticket will need to be opened with the helpdesk (<u>HelpDesk@us.abb.com</u>).

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Adding Labels to the Printer/Company Name Change

Adding Labels to Printer

 Users should reach out to the data administrators of the PDD Labels systems based on their region to prepare the product labels and set up a new WP (Where Print) for them. The administrators are responsible for inserting labels records, updating label data, and remove labels from PDD.

Company Name Change

Generally, name change is not done as it involves changing the printer's name. If printer name is changed, it calls for modification of all associated labels of the customer.

PDD Access and Printer Setup Issues

PDD Printer setup Issues

External IP Address Setup for Vendors/Suppliers

- PDD Printer application uses an FTP connection and hence PDD needs a public IP address.
- Quite often users provide a private IP of the printer not the IP exposed to the outside world.
- This issue can be resolved by involving the network engineers of Vendors/Suppliers and also providing them with source IP address of PDD server.
- The printer should be configured to accept FTP connections.
- User's firewall should be configured to route FTP (port 21) traffic to the printer from PDD server **ftp-public.tnb.com** (IP 199.120.203.99)
