Introduction

This document explains, how to download the parametrization of a MT701.2 over RS232 interface using a step-by-step guide. With this process the complete parameters are transmitted from the Plug-In to the panel.

Objectives of the document

- With this document a programmer should be able to handle a download of a MT701.2.
- Furthermore it suggests what should be noticed when starting this process.

Content

To view the control and display tableau in the Plug-In first it has to be downloaded on our product site. After successful installation the .VD3 file can be found under the following path

„C:\Program Files(x86)\Ets3PlugIn\Ets3LkExt“.

This file has to be imported into the product catalog of the ETS. The MT701.2 can then be inserted into the project.

1. Before it is possible to start the download, the interface has to be set under “Download RS232” -> “Setup”.

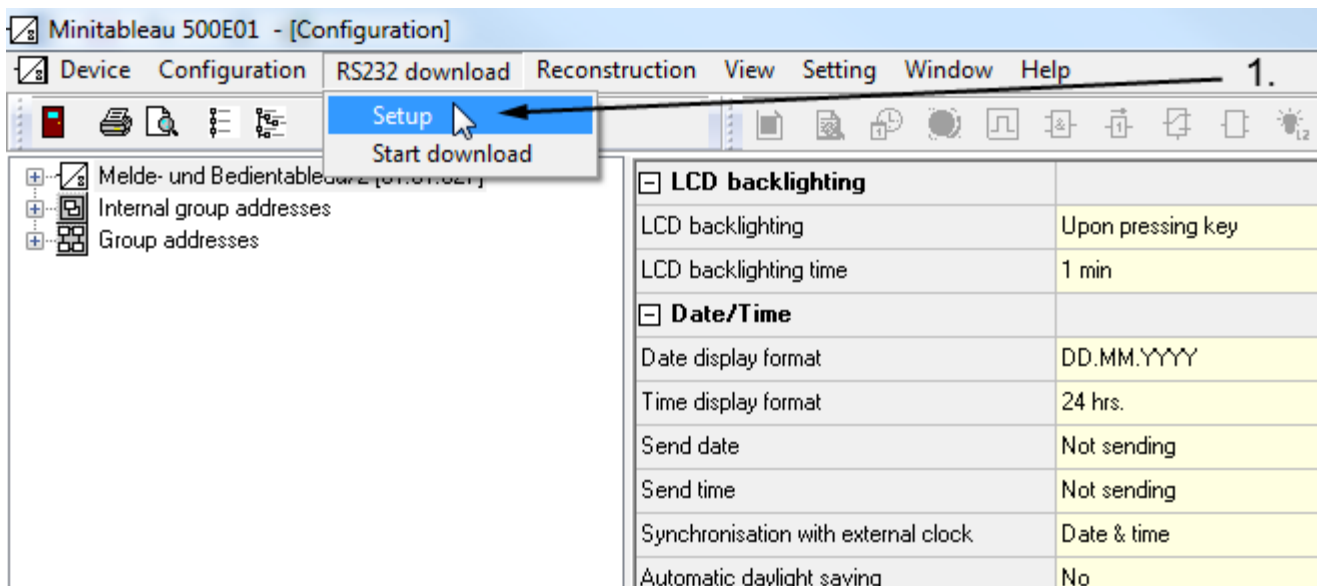


Figure 1: Open setup

2. The right interface is shown on the PC under “Windows system control” → “Device manager”.

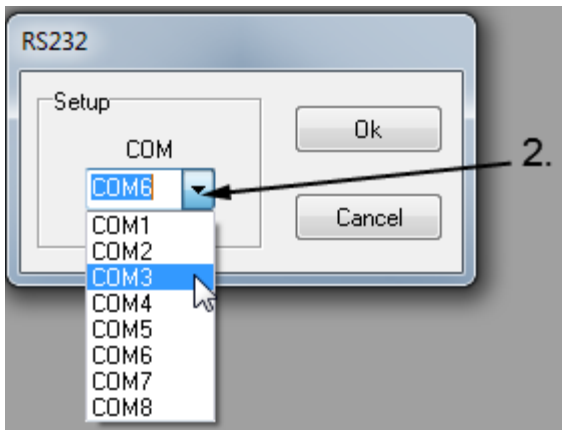


Figure 2: Select interface

3. After that, the download can start by clicking “Download RS232” → “Start download”.

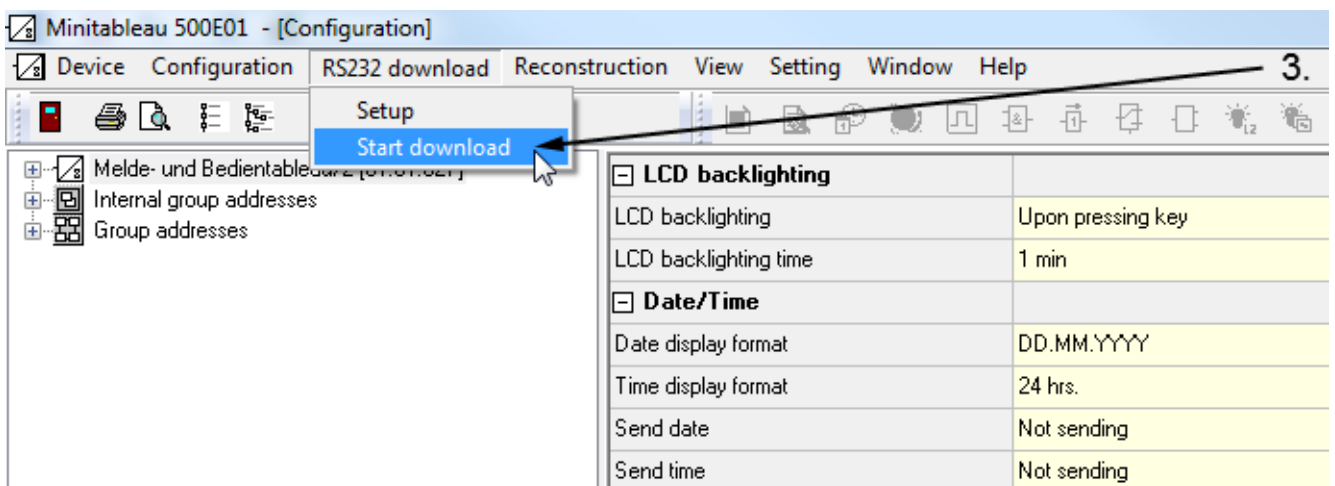


Figure 3: Start download

4. After a successful download the process is terminated automatically.

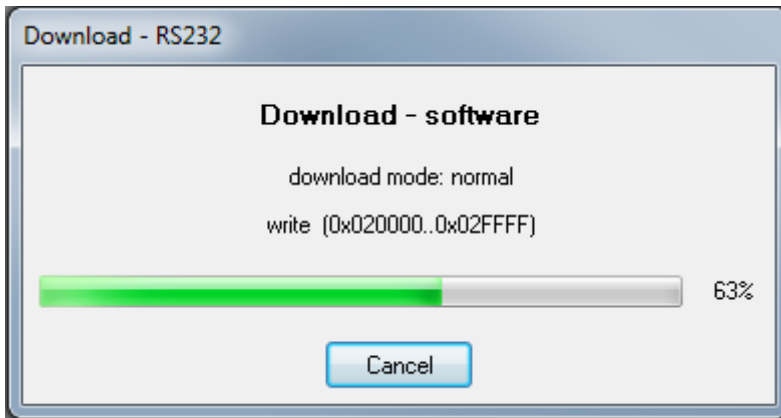


Figure 4: Download progress
