Considerations before traveling

When arriving and attending site

Read and follow all local health authority and ABB travel security updates for the work location and the route that you will be traveling.	Yes	No	If you have any questions or concerns about entering the site, please discuss them with your Line Manager.
Are there any health and safety advisories related to the travel route or site location?	Yes	No	If risk or concerns are identified along the route or near the location of the site where the work is to be performed consult your Line Manager before proceeding.
Check for travel advisories relating to the mode of transportation you intend to use to travel to the site if traveling by public transportation.	Yes	No	If advisories are in effect consult with your Line Manager and discuss possible alternative modes of transportation.
Contact the customer contact who is responsible for the work to be performed and review the Site Pre-visit customer contact ST-5	Yes	No	If you find there are specific concerns related to the site where the work is to be performed consult you Line Manager for guidance on health and safety concerns and mitigation.
Confirm that you have the PPE available that is prescribed by the customer for the site visit.	Yes	No	If not, contact your Line Manager for direction on obtaining the proper PPE.
All considerations and risks for travel and the site have been reviewed and travel and work deemed to be in compliance with the ABB and government H&S directives.	Yes	No	Proceed with work after all risks identified have been mitigated by modification of the travel or work site or after discussion with your Line Manager on any remaining concerns.

Continual assessment

Continue to monitor government health advisory updates and adjust your travel and site visit plans according to the advisories if needed. Report changes to your work or travel itinerary.


