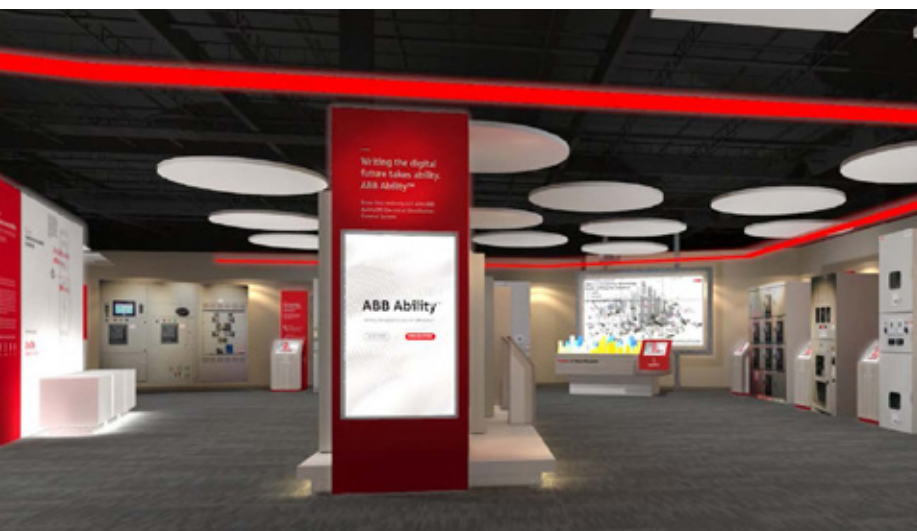

### Class fee

Each class has a tuition of \$550/person and can be covered directly from distributor marketing funds.

This cost covers instruction, transportation to and from the hotel to the training center and lunch during classes. (Note: Travel and hotel information will be available upon registration.)

### Safety notes

Visitors touring the shop areas will be issued a visitor badge, safety glasses and hearing protection, which is required for the fabrication area.

Steel-toed safety shoes are required for walking through the shop areas. If you do not have safety shoes, ABB can provide toe covers for your visit, but your shoes must cover your entire foot.

Long pants are required in the fabrication department. Long skirts that completely cover legs and ankles with no splits are acceptable.
